

**Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene**  
**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**



**All up and coming bands with a connection to the Tuggeranong Valley are invited to join Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene, hosted by Tuggeranong Arts Centre**

Eight finalists will be selected to film a music video live with a professional videographer on **11/12 September 2024**. A live screening of the 8 music videos will be held **Saturday 16 November** as part of SouthFest and 2 bands will have the opportunity to perform live on the day.

### Eligibility

1. Band of two or more members
2. Have a connection to Tuggeranong
3. Aged 13 – 18 and 19 – 25 years.
4. Should be available to perform on event related activities and performances on:
  - Open mic nights on 8 or 15 August
  - Music video live recording on 11 or 12 September
  - Live performance and video screening at the TAC Grand Day Out during SouthFest

### Entry process

1. Record a video of your band playing one original or cover track (original preferred)
2. Agree to the terms and conditions detailed below. Note that **media consent is required**, as your video will be shared on our social pages as part of the judging process and event promotion.
3. Complete the entry form on Tuggeranong Arts Centre's website. Upload a video of one track (or provide the link) and an image of your band.
4. Entries must be in by Thursday 1 August 2024
5. Your entry will be uploaded on Tuggeranong Arts and Battle of the Bands Facebook and Instagram pages.
6. 8 bands will be announced by Tues 6 August and invited to perform live at Tuggeranong Arts Centre with a professional videographer on either 11 or 12 September for a 1 hour time slot between 4:30pm and 10:30pm
7. 2 bands will be invited to perform live at TAC's Grand Day Out during SouthFest on 16 November.
8. Edited music videos will be screened in Tuggeranong Arts Centre's theatre during the TAC Grand Day Out SouthFest event on 16 November.
9. Music videos will be shared on Tuggeranong Arts and Battle of the Bands Facebook and Instagram pages and bands will receive MP4 files of their videos after the SouthFest event.

By submitting an entry into the Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene event, entrants:

1. Provide consent for Tuggeranong Arts Centre and Battle of the Bands to utilise the video and images provided for the purposes of judging and promotion of Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene and on Facebook and Instagram in relation to the competition and showcasing local talent.
2. Acknowledge that our video/s may be used to promote Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene without any personal compensation or remuneration.
3. Note that Tuggeranong Arts Centre agrees to always credit the band within the text associated with the use of the image or video.
4. Acknowledge that the video will remain the property of Tuggeranong Arts Centre and any personal details regarding this content will be kept confidentially and will not be used for any purpose other than related to your image.
5. Understand that any image or video which is published online can be copied and redistributed without the knowledge of the person that uploaded it. Once published, Tuggeranong Arts Centre may not be able to retrieve or delete videos or images if consent is withdrawn after publishing.

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. The Promoter is Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene, under the auspices of the Tuggeranong Community Arts Association
2. Entrants must live, attend school, or have a connection to the Tuggeranong Valley.
3. Performances must showcase the original work of the entrant (noting that cover performances are accepted).
4. The content will be used on the Battle of the Bands and Tuggeranong Arts Centre public Instagram, Facebook accounts and website, may be broadcast at events and used in future Tuggeranong Arts Centre promotions. By entering, the entrant confirms that they have permissions for all people shown in the video for this level of publication.
5. Entries close at 11:59 on the 1 August 2024
6. Eight finalists will be notified by 6 August 2024 through the details provided in the entry form. Finalists will be invited to perform at Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene in Tuggeranong Arts Centre's theatre with a professional videographer on either 11 or 12 September 2024.
7. In entering a video and photograph, the entrant gives permission to Tuggeranong Arts Centre to reproduce and display the image in publications, including: social media posts, other digital and printed materials relating to promoting Battle of the Bands, TAC's Grand Day Out and celebrating local talent. The text associated with the use of photo will always credit the photographer. The entrant acknowledges that there will be no remuneration for entry and performance in the Battle of the Bands: Make a Scene events.
8. This is a game of skill.
9. The Promoter's decision in choosing finalists and awarding prizes is final.

10. The Promoter shall not be liable for any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to indirect or consequential loss) or for any personal injury suffered or sustained from the prize, except for any liability, which cannot by law be excluded.
11. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these.
12. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
